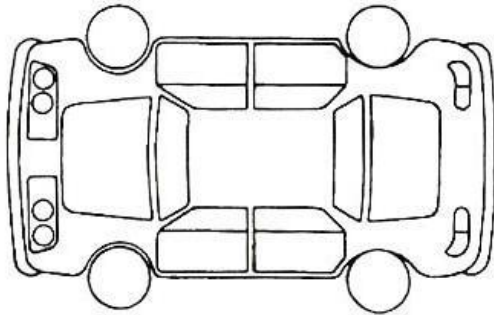

Glue Paintless Dent Removal (GPDR) can be used if access cannot be gained to the dent. Glue pulling is a new and very successful technique used to remove dents with limited access. However, owners should be aware that there is a slight risk of the paint being pulled off. This rarely happens but there is a small risk especially if the panel has been repainted or paint is damaged. If you have any queries please ask a technician and they will gladly fill you in on the pros and cons of GPDR
